Illness

We know that illness is unavoidable and to be expected. However it is very important to inform the school on the first day of the absence with the reason either by phone (0191 5536921).



Lateness

Did you know that being 15 minutes late each day is the same as missing two weeks of school over the year. Lateness is just as serious as non-

attendance. The start of the school day is an important time for children to develop their social skills with their peers, as well as preparing them for their learning. We start teaching at 8.55am and 'late' children miss out on vital skills such as phonics and/or basic number work.



Did you know.....

- For every school day missed by a pupil it will reduce their attendance by 0.5%
- Ten whole days of school has been missed if your child has 95% attendance.
- Twenty whole days of school has been missed if a pupil's attendance is 90%.
- By the time a pupil is persistently absent (85% attendance) they have missed 6 weeks of school or half a term of schooling.
