Class Teachers will inform you of reading book days and homework books in the next few weeks when routines have been established.

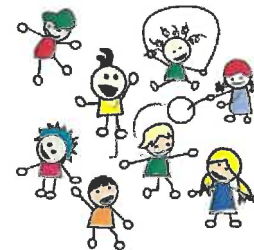
PE Kit/Bags
